

GETTING STARTED AT DSLCC

1. APPLY ONLINE

Apply for admission to Dabney S. Lancaster Community College at www.dslcc.edu

2. APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

Apply on-line at: www.fafsa.ed.gov. Re-apply for financial aid by March 1st each year.

3. TAKE THE PLACEMENT TEST

Did you take the SAT or ACT exam? The placement test will be waived for students receiving the following scores on the SAT/ACT exam.*

- ✓ ACT—Verbal 20, Math 18 (20 to enroll in pre-calculus or higher math)
- ✓ SAT—Critical Reading 480, Math 440 (480 to enroll in pre-calculus or higher math)

*Students are required to submit a copy of their score report prior to registering for classes.

If you don't meet the criteria listed above, don't worry. Just call 261-1211, option #3, to make an appointment to take a free placement exam.

IMPORTANT: Please brush up on math and English skills prior to testing. Although you cannot fail the test, you are placed in classes based on your test scores so it is **very important** that you do your **VERY BEST** on the test.
